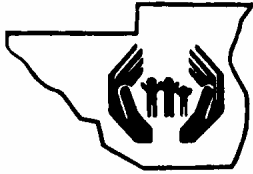

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H1N1 Flu Vaccination Clinics

Pike County Health Department will be offering H1N1 flu vaccination clinics at the health department from 9 am to 5 pm on the following Fridays in November: November 6th, November 13th, and November 20th. According to CDC guidelines, persons must meet one of the following criteria to be eligible to receive the vaccine:

- Age 6 mo. thru 24 years of age
- Pregnant
- Caregiver or household member of child under 6 months of age
- Adult age 25 to 64 with chronic health condition, such as asthma or diabetes
- Health care or emergency medical services personnel

Both the nasal spray and injectable form of the vaccine are available. A parent or guardian must sign the consent form for those under the age of 18.

Walk-in H1N1 vaccination clinics will also be available in November ONLY from 3 pm to 5 pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays (except Holidays).
