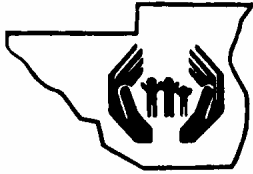

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H1N1 Flu Vaccination Clinics

Pike County Health Department will be offering an additional H1N1 flu vaccination clinic at the health department from 9 am to 2 pm on Friday, December 18th. No other walk-in services such as blood pressure checks, will be available that day.

- According to Illinois Department of Public Health, the CDC guidelines have been lifted effective December 15th and **everyone, regardless of risk status is now eligible to receive the H1N1 vaccine.**

Both the nasal spray and injectable form of the vaccine are available at no cost. A parent or guardian must sign the consent form for those under the age of 18. Children under the age of 10 must receive 2 doses of the vaccine separated by at least 28 days.

H1N1 vaccine will also be available on a walk-in basis in December from 3 pm to 5 pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays (except Holidays).
